PDFs and other documents

What is being done to improve accessibility

We will be running regular accessibility checks and ensure that new content added to the website meets accessibility requirements where possible.

Preparation of this accessibility statement

This statement was prepared on 11th July 2025 and will be reviewed on at least an annual basis. The website was last tested on 23rd December 2025. The test was carried out via Winsford Town Council (self-evaluation) on representative pages following the Government accessibility checklist. We focused on the most popular website pages to test, including the homepage and the meetings documents page.
